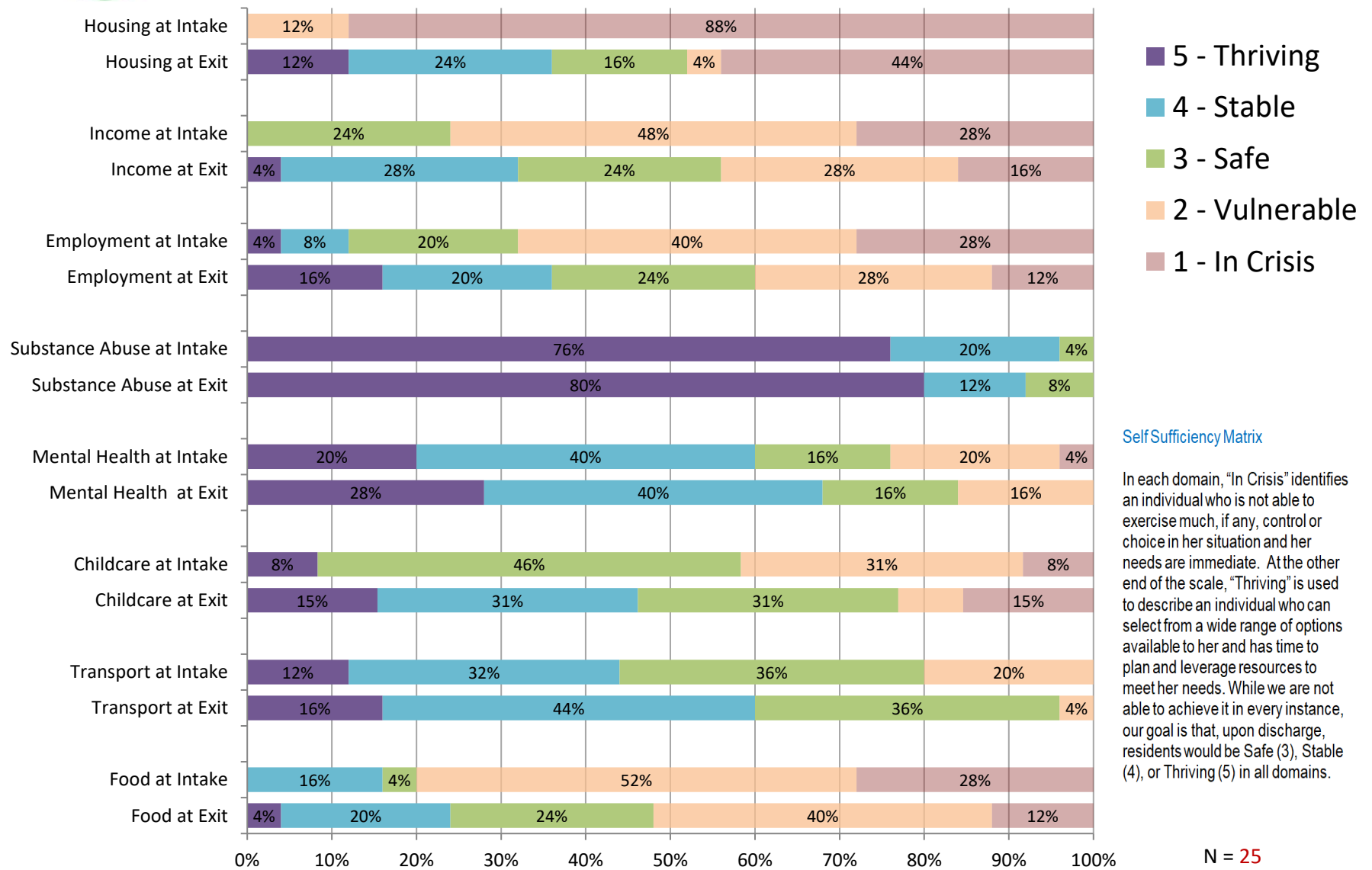




Self-Sufficiency Status at Intake and Exit for Residents Completing Program, FYTD 2020 (06/30/2020)



Self-Sufficiency Matrix

In each domain, "In Crisis" identifies an individual who is not able to exercise much, if any, control or choice in her situation and her needs are immediate. At the other end of the scale, "Thriving" is used to describe an individual who can select from a wide range of options available to her and has time to plan and leverage resources to meet her needs. While we are not able to achieve it in every instance, our goal is that, upon discharge, residents would be Safe (3), Stable (4), or Thriving (5) in all domains.
